

Bahureksa manual owner 's guide

OVERVIEW

Read this owner's manual in its entirety and follow all instructions. By acquainting yourself with proper helmet fit, care, and features you may reduce the chance during an impact.

Bahureksa Riding Helmets are made to the highest world class standards in helmet safety providing riders with quality, comfort and attractive looks at the same time
A helmet is lined with soft foam wrap. The foam wrap absorbs the impact. The hard shell spreads the area of contact over a much larger load bearing area. The expected life span of a helmet for the average rider is five years.

A helmet protects only what it covers. It does not protect the neck or any area of the head it doesn't cover. Always wear a helmet low in the front to protect the forehead. Make sure the helmet fits snugly and toe straps are adjusted to hold the helmet firmly in place when tightly fastened.

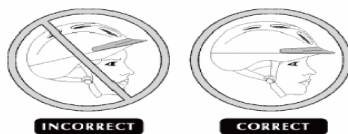
No Helmet can prevent all types of head injuries. Even with a helmet meeting ASTM standards in place, under certain conditions riding or equestrian driving accidents can cause head injury resulting in death. Make sure all retention straps are fastened snugly and securely. If your helmet suffers an impact, it should be destroyed and replaced.

ACHIEVING A PROPER FIT

To be effective, the helmet must fit firmly but comfortably. A helmet that is too loose may slip, possibly reducing its capabilities, and one that is too tight may cause discomfort. Try on your helmet. If it is too small or too large, exchange it for the proper size.

When a helmet fits properly, it will not easily roll forward or backward and it should not be removable without unbuckling the chin strap. Some helmet styles are equipped with padded inserts. This may be placed inside the helmet liner if need be. If you have an oval shaped head you may require pads in the sides of your helmet liner. A properly fitted helmet will be comfortable and not fit so tightly that it causes discomfort.

WARNING: The chin-strap is an integral part of your helmet's protection system. It must be properly adjusted and used. The chin-strap must fit well under the chin, up against the throat, and be as snug as possible.



CARE AND CLEANING

* Hand wash in cold water and mild detergent * Keep Dry, do not soak, do not place in dryer * Mud on velvet is best left to dry and then brushed off. * After riding, leave the helmet in a warm, dry place overnight. Do not dry in front of a fire & do not store it in a plastic bag before dry. This will reduce the risk of rusting of the metal components
* Heat damage is not covered under Bahureksa's Warranty * Fasten all retention straps securely and snug * helmets should not be exposed to or stored near volatile chemicals such as acids, solvents, pool chemicals, paints, paint thinners, pesticides and herbicides. Storing of this near solvents can damage the felt. * Impact can cause unseen damage to the helmet, Return for replacement after accident, or destroy helmet and replace.

WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMER

This Helmet is designed only for equestrian use. No helmet can protect the wearer against all foreseeable impacts. Under certain conditions riding or driving accidents can cause serious injury or death. The helmet must fit well, and all retention straps must be securely fastened. These helmets are constructed so that the energy of an impact may be absorbed through partial destruction of the headgear, through damage may not be visible to the naked eye. If it suffers such an impact, it should be destroyed or replaced. This helmet can be seriously damaged by some common substances without any visible damage.

Any Bahureksa helmet found to be defective in materials and/or workmanship within one year from the date of purchase will be repaired or replaced at the option of the manufacturer free of charge when received at the factory, freight prepaid. this helmet provides no protection to parts of the body it does not cover directly.

Any modifications made by the user will render the warranty null and void. bahureksa shall not be liable for any incidental or consequential damages in connection with the purchase, use or handling of the helmet.
